

Diagnose asthma If symptoms suggest asthma AND	A FeNO level of 35ppb or more and positive peak flow variability
	Obstructive spirometry and positive bronchodilator reversibility
	Response to treatment
Suspect asthma If symptoms suggest asthma AND	A FeNO level of 35ppb or more with normal spirometry and negative peak flow variability
	A FeNO level of 35ppb or more with obstructive spirometry but negative bronchodilator reversibility and no variability in peak flow
	Normal spirometry, a FeNO level of 34ppb or less and positive peak flow variability
	Response to treatment
